Selectmen's meeting convened at 5:45 p.m. for an Executive Session to discuss compensation. The meeting re-convened at 6:00 p.m. with Selectman Mixon, Selectman Young, Selectman House and Administrator Jones present.

I. Executive Session

1. Per Title 30 M.R.S.A. 405 § 6A, the Selectmen met in Executive Session to discuss compensation.

II. New Business

1. Consider Posted Road Reduced-Load Exemptions for JBR Maine LLC.

The Board has been contacted by JBR Maine that they are not going to have enough time between now and Friday evening, when the roads will be posted, to get their exemptions taken care of. Selectman Mixon's recommendation was to authorize the Town Administrator to sign on the Board's behalf to get them through until our next meeting where we will sign the permanent documentation. Selectman Young added that JBR Marine LLC was the prior Purse Line Bait and because they carry perishable product, which is the bait, they are allowed to have an exemption underneath our Ordinance for heavy weight vehicles, posted roads. This is done every year.

Vote: Selectman Young motioned to authorize the Town Administrator to review and sign 2020 Overweight Exemption Certificates for JBR Maine LLC in accordance with Section 5K Vehicle Hauling Perishable Product, of the 1998 Town of Phippsburg Ordinance for restricting vehicle weight on posted roads as amended through January 2007. These 2020 Exemption Certificates will be issued to those vehicles on the JBR LLC exemption list they provided to be used February 21st - February 26th, 2020. All further vehicle exemption certificates must be approved at future Selectmen meetings. The maximum allowed payload and gross weight will be based on the DOT gross weight allowance chart. Exemptions certificates must be carried in the vehicle and JBR LLC must supply gross weight vehicle information, each run, to the Town Office for review. This motion was seconded by Julia House and passed by a vote of 3-0.
