

Phippsburg Rec. Meeting February 5, 2025

Treasurer's Report-

- Minott Walking Path: \$18,347.32
- Rec General Account: \$16,760.57

Copier-

- There are 2 years left on the copier lease. Cathy has tried several times, but is still waiting to hear back from the company what the penalty will cost. Call 207-623-2679. Copier is paid up; have paid for February.

CPR Class January 18th, 8am-12pm at Phippsburg Fire Station-

- Went well; some people have asked for another class, and a "Stop the Bleed" class. Jula will ask Ben for a Saturday date in March/April that works for him.
- No minimum; maximum of 10 participants.

Children's Museum of Portland Tickets-

- Sold 15; have 15 tickets left. They don't expire.

Walking Path Sign-

- Shana saw a sign at another track and wondered if Rec could put one on the Minott Walking Path fence stating how many laps equal a mile and a half mile. Cathy said 5 laps is a mile. Two & ½ laps would be ½ mile.
- Amber said we could reach out to Banana Banners, Sunset Signs (mostly vinyl), or Carrot Signs (specialize in engraving).

Amber reached out on Facebook for anyone interested in leading a strength and conditioning class for Phippsburg senior citizens-

- No one responded.
- Tammy may have found someone named Nicola Eden who offers Chair Yoga on-line for Merrymeeting Adult Education. Nicola charges \$75 for 5-week session; will try for 1-hour class Tuesdays in March and April, and is willing to teach in-person. Rec could cover \$25 scholarship per resident. Tammy should check with Merry and see if she has any friends interested in participating.
- Jenny Leeman & Beauregards aren't available.
- Diane Cohen, who taught Fiesta Fitness (participants very interested in another session), is willing to do some strength and conditioning, and Fiesta Fitness after. Available May 28 through July 3, 2025. Tammy initially asked about Wednesdays, but will ask to switch to Thursday evenings instead, as better day for half of the attendees. Previously, cost: \$50/person.

Mariner Tickets-

- Jula will look into purchasing some tickets for a game in mid-April that we can list in the next Rec flyer. They cost \$19; we have to purchase 10 or more for group rate. Rec will sell for \$10 each.

Cathy-

- Cathy has resigned as Treasurer. The Board thanks her for her 20+ years of service.
- She will need to gather and turn in the financial records and keys to the Board ASAP, and we will need to complete a new signature card at the banks.
- Gave Amber a deposit ticket so she can deposit the calendar payments she received.
- Treasurer should be someone who is or has been on the Rec Board.

Future events-

- Amber stated there is some interest in a crochet class.
- Christina McCue at BRCTC may be interested in teaching crochet. Amber will check to see her cost and availability; are supplies provided or do students need to buy? One-time class or 4 weeks?
- Line Dancing for April? Gracie Hawkes is not available. Amber found a source with Silver Spur on Facebook. They are open Saturday only; an Auburn-based dance hall. Amber will try reaching them to see if they'd do a class at the PES gym, and cost. If they won't come here, maybe Rec could provide tickets or info for people interested in going to Auburn to dance.
- Rec voted yes to sponsor the Gr. 1-5 Kids Theater Club at PES. Sarah Mancini was paid \$75. Parents paid Sarah Mancini directly for each child. PES gave 4 \$50 scholarships. Sixteen students registered, so the class is full.
- Cathy emailed Sponge at the Bath YMCA to get some YMCA Day Passes; hasn't heard back from him, yet.
- Amber has looked into Jen's Wooden Wonders for door hanger painting night; 18" sign cost \$45/person; 15" sign is \$35/person. Rec can give \$10 off for residents; need a minimum of 15 people for the event. If can have a choice of sign design, that would be best. Originally suggested St. Patrick's or Easter theme. Amber will offer choice of dates to see if Jen's could do one evening: Fri, March 28, Sat, March 29, or Sat, Apr 5, 2025.
- Possible Easter Egg Hunt, Saturday, April 19, 2025. We have totes of eggs in Rec shed. Amber will check Rec book for details of previous egg hunts. PES gym will be backup if weather is bad on Apr. 19.
