

## Good Morning Participant Application Process

*Below are the steps involved in 'signing-up' new participants into the Good Morning Program.*

1. Participants will:

Fill out the attached Participation Information Form and the Release Form.

2. Participants will be provided with instructions on how the program works, the call in number, and the contact information enabling them to make changes or ask further questions.
3. Participants will be contacted when they should start calling into the program, usually within a few days of applying.
4. Participants are asked to notify the Good Morning Program, using their call in number, with any changes or requests to suspend or cancel the program.
5. All participant information is kept securely at the Sagadahoc Sheriff's Department.

## THE GOOD MORNING PROGRAM

### WHAT IS THE GOOD MORNING PROGRAM?

The Good Morning Program is a telephone reassurance program. This program is for older adults or adults with disabilities that might be at risk of sudden illness, falls, accidents and social isolation.

### IS THERE ANY CHARGE FOR THIS SERVICE?

No. This is a free service provided by the Sagadahoc County Sheriff's Department. It will be available to older and disabled adults living in the Towns of West Bath, Woolwich, Arrowsic, Georgetown, & Phippsburg.

### HOW DOES THE GOOD MORNING PROGRAM WORK?

Each morning from the time the participant wakes up until 10:00 a.m. an automated service will be available to leave a message. If someone has not checked in by 10:00 a.m., a volunteer will try and make contact with them.

### HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE IN THE GOOD MORNING PROGRAM?

You can call or stop by the Sagadahoc Sheriff's Department and complete the enrollment application and waiver. A letter with the guidelines for the program will be given to you. Expect to make a daily call to the Good Morning program.

### ARE THERE ANY RESTRICTIONS REGARDING WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

You must be a resident of West Bath, Woolwich, Arrowsic, Georgetown, or Phippsburg. You must be 60 years of age or older or an adult with disabilities of any age; and you must agree to make a daily telephone call. You must also agree to let us know when you plan to be away.

### WHAT IF I HAVE A LIFELINE?

The Good Morning Program is a great compliment to LifeLine because you make a daily telephone call to the Good Morning Program Coordinator. LifeLine is a separate program for emergencies such as falls or accidents, or health problems requiring emergency assistance.

The participant will be notified by phone that he/she is currently enrolled in the Good Morning Program.
