

MOORINGS FOR 2020

The Harbor Commission recommends that all moorings should still be registered and paid for. If we have your paperwork on file from last year and there are no changes, no further paperwork needs to be submitted. Mooring fees can be paid by check via US mail and include a self-addressed stamped envelope so we can mail your receipt and mooring sticker back to you or you can leave payment in the drop box outside of Town Hall and we can put the receipt and stickers in there for you to pick up.

However, given the pandemic and the fact that it seems the State is being more relaxed about registrations, etc. the Commission feels it would be improper for us to enforce the late fees or reassigning mooring locations due to a failure to pay and/or register. So, no late fees will be enforced or locations reassigned.

All new mooring registrations will still need to be approved by the Harbor Master, Doug Alexander. The link to the 2020 Mooring Application is below.
