The Board Chair position remains vacant. The Board is seeking an individual with leadership abilities and a creative mind to join them in providing the Town of Phippsburg residents with all the great events and fun activities of the past and create new exciting events of the future. These events provide entertainment and education opportunities to all ages of our town.

The Phippsburg Recreation is a Town funded and owned commission consisting of five board members, who must be Town residents. They meet monthly on the first Wednesday at 6pm at the Phippsburg Fire House, where they organize upcoming events, discuss Town events and how they can provide assistance, and determine any maintenance that needs to be made to the Cushman Field and the Minott Walking Path (located next to the Phippsburg Elementary School).

Town management, including the Board of Selectmen, oversee how the Rec. board spends the funds appropriated and the Rec. board maintains bank accounts and compiles annual financial reports which can be found in the Town's Annual Report. The Rec. board position holders are appointed by the Board of Selectmen and receive an annual stipend for their time serving the Town of Phippsburg.

PLT Preserve of the Season: Wilbur Preserve

Celebrate the Phippsburg Land Trust's 50th anniversary by hiking this 1/4 mile marked trail (near the end of Cox Head Road) through an apple orchard, ascending through the woods, past a spring fed pond which once provided water to nearby summer homes, up to a Revolutionary War garrison on the summit. The stunning view from this summit includes all of Atkins Bay, the western coasts of Georgetown, and to the south the Popham Colony area, Popham Village, and Fort Popham and the islands off the beach. An additional loop trail begins just in from the parking spaces and meanders through the apple trees and mixed forest of the south face of the hill. Enjoying the Wilbur Preserve Trail is an entertaining activity to highlight the beauty of Phippsburg with our summer visitors.
