

**TOWN OF PHIPPSBURG
SELECTMEN'S MEETING
September 18, 2018
Minutes**

Selectmen convened on Tuesday at 5:00 p.m. at the Town Hall to meet in Executive Session to conduct three interviews with applicants for the Road Committee, Selectman Mixon and Selectman Young were present.

I. Executive Session

1. Met in Executive Session per M.R.S.A. 405 6.A to conduct Road Committee Interviews. Opened the meeting at 5:10 p.m. with Selectman Mixon and Young present. Selectman Read was absent.

Joshua Bate, one of three applicants for two open positions on the Road Committee, informed the Selectmen that he refused to be interviewed in Executive Session for the position and left the meeting after presenting the Selectmen with a complaint letter.

Vote: Selectman Mixon made a motion to recess until 5:30 p.m. The motion was seconded by Selectman Young and passed vote 2-0.

The meeting was reconvened at 5:25 p.m. to interview two other applicants for the two open positions on the Road Committee.

Vote: At 5:26 p.m. Selectman Young made a motion to enter into Executive Session as per M.R.S.A. 405 6.A to conduct interviews for two open positions on the Road Committee. The motion was seconded by Selectman Mixon and passed vote 2-0.

At 6:17 the Selectmen came out of Executive Session.

Vote: At 6:18 p.m. Selectman Mixon made a motion to recess until 6:30 p.m. The motion was seconded by Selectman Young and passed vote 2-0.

At 6:30 p.m. the meeting was reconvened for an emergency meeting with Selectman Read, Selectman Mixon and Selectman Young present to consider closing Stoneybrook Road (both lanes) for approximately an hour on Thursday morning September 20th for an internment in a private cemetery, and then later at 2:00 p.m. (one lane) again for an hour to accommodate traffic related to the graveside service.

Vote: Selectman Young made a motion to close both lanes of Stoneybrook Road on Thursday morning from 9:00 - 10:00 a.m. for George Bowker's internment and one lane at 2:00 p.m. for those attending the graveside service, which was seconded by Selectman Mixon and passed vote 3-0.

II. Adjournment

Vote: At 6:40 p.m. Selectman Mixon motioned to adjourn, which was seconded by Selectman Young and passed by a vote of 3-0.
